Douglas County and the Minden-Tahoe Airport Announce Aviation Roundup Lineup Including a Return of the Thunderbirds

Minden, Nev. — Douglas County and the Minden-Tahoe Airport are pleased to announce the lineup for the Aviation Roundup to be held at the Minden-Tahoe Airport Oct 7-8, 2017. It will include:

- **USAF Thunderbirds:** The team will base eight F16 Falcons at the Minden-Tahoe Airport for the event and do their full ground and air show each day.
- **US Army Golden Knights Parachute Team:** The team will do tandem jumps and a series of aerial maneuvers on both days.
- **Royal Canadian Air Force CF 18 Fighter Jet Demo:** They will celebrate the 150th birthday of Canada while performing in Minden on both Saturday and Sunday.
- **US Navy Super Hornet:** It will make a return appearance and perform each day.
- **Rob Holland:** The six-time consecutive world champion will demonstrate his aerobatic skills.
- **The Alabama Boys:** This is a fun filled comedy act which will conclude with the aircraft landing on top of a pickup truck.
- **Smoke and Thunder:** This jet-powered truck will put on an amazing show for car buffs and race one of the aircraft.
- **Bob Carlton:** Bob will fly a jet-powered glider and do a series of aerobatic maneuvers.
