DOUGLAS COUNTY RE-ROOFING/SIDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- Solid sheeting is required in Douglas County.
- In climate areas subject to wind-driven snow, roof ice damming is required and shall be installed per the current Building Code.
(Note: Not required below 6,000 ft.)
- In fire-restrictive areas within the County, a minimum of Class B roof covering is required.
- Prior to any new roof covering or siding installed, contact and verify with the Fire Marshal having jurisdiction in this area, where all the fire-restrictive areas within the County apply.
(Note: If a partial re-roof/siding of 50% or more is being replaced in a fire-restrictive area, the entire roof or structure must be replaced with a minimum of Class B roof covering.)
- New roof materials installed must meet the current Building Code's wind and exposure requirements.
