It's normal to experience loneliness from time to time. The following are suggestions to help increase feelings of connection.

- **Join a class or club** to expose yourself to others who share a common interest.
- Volunteer to meet others who also believe in a cause that is important to you.
- **Join an online group** such as a Facebook or Meetup groups (taking caution with your personal information).
- **Strengthen relationships** that exist in your life currently by reaching out to people whose company you enjoy.
- Adopt a pet which can help open up a community of others who enjoy the company of pets.
- Engage with others you come into contact with throughout the day to increase social exchanges.
- **Consider seeing a therapist** if you feel lonely or anxious even when surrounded by others, or to develop strategies to feel more connected.
