

DOUGLAS COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES ADVISORY COUNCIL

BY-LAWS

I. CREATION

The Douglas County Senior Services Advisory Council is created to effectively and efficiently advise the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County of matters relating to senior needs in Douglas County.

II. MEMBERSHIP

The council shall consist of nine (9) members, seven (7) of whom shall be Voting members, six (6) appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, one (1) elected by the Young-at-Heart Senior Citizen's Club, and two (2) ex-officio non-voting members. The two (2) ex-officio member shall be the Director of Community Services and the Senior Services Supervisor.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

The qualification necessary to become a member of the Douglas County Senior Services Advisory Council is to be a resident of Douglas County. Applications may be obtained from the County Manager's office located at the Minden Inn, 1594 Esmeralda Avenue in Minden.

IV. APPOINTMENT – TERM- VACANCIE3S- REMOVAL- COMPENSATION

1. Six (6) members of the Senior Services Advisory Council shall be appointed by the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, with approval of the Board.
2. The term of each member shall be two (2) years.
3. Appointments to the Senior Services Advisory Council shall be staggered, three (3) in odd years, three (3) in even years.
4. Vacancies occurring, other than through the expiration of term shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as set forth above.
5. Members may be removed, after public hearing by a majority vote of the Board of County Commissioners for inefficiency, neglect of duty or malfeasance of office.
