Discussion:

- a) Must have league roster prior to 2nd game
- b) May add players up to 4th week
- c) Max 12 players on the roster will be loosely managed

- f) Must be 18 or older
- g) Games will be played at DCCC

Items up for vote, and results

- 1) Playing spring break: **We will not play on spring break**
- 2) Thoughts on Double headers: **Yes, we will play double headers**
- 3) # of women on court in Coed division: **There may be up to 2 more women than men, but only one more male than female**

- 4) Service line infractions: You may step on the service line, but not over on the overhang side only.
- 5) April 19th Business Showcase. Tentatively, we will play on Friday night April 20th unless managers unanimously decide to move those games to May 14th.
- 6) Thoughts on playing with 2: You may play with only 2 players if that's all you have.
- 7) Third game played to 15, regardless of time: Third game will be played to 15/win by 2 regardless of time, and will be capped at 21

- 10) Protests: Eligibility, and rule Interpretations no judgement calls
