

Resolution No. 2007R-053

A Resolution establishing the distribution of available allocations between the individual and project pool for the administration of the Building Permit Allocation and Growth Management Ordinance.

The Douglas County Board of Commissioners has decided to implement a building permit cap by adopting a growth management ordinance no. 2007-1199.

The growth management ordinance section 20.560.110(A) requires that the Board account for banking and borrowing and determine the distribution of the available allocations between the individual and project pools.

Based on information received, the Board desires to distribute the allocations for the 2007-2008 fiscal year.

The Board of Douglas County Commissioners resolves as follows:

Section 1. The number of allocations, as defined in section 20.560.070, distributed to the individual pool is 70% of the total annual allocations available and the number of allocations distributed to the project pool is 30% for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. This distribution will continue until changed by the Board.


