Funds were used to purchase new LED lights for the stage at the CVIC Hall in Minden and to install them. These lights are available for use by all groups who use the hall for any purpose

All lights were installed and are operating at full capacity. The lights were used in a recent CVCT production and worked at full capacity. They are cooler and are capable of being manipulated to have a limitless number of colors that can be created from the lightboard and do not require the light operator to have to climb a ladder and hand install gels on each light by hand. They are all functioning as they should and are operating well. This will allow CVCT to create more depth and provide a wider variety of lighting options during our productions. It will allow other groups to have a more comfortable environment onstage as they will have cooler lights and will be able to adjust the colors more easily.

Due to shipping and other vendor challenges, we were not able to get these lights prior to this production so this is the first time we have been able to use them for an actual production. They are now fully installed and available for all groups to use.
